Put your tax money to good use.

Sales taxes fund Louisville including vital services such as police, water and street repairs.



Give Back to Your Community.

Small businesses donate more than twice as much per sales dollar to local non-profits, schools, events, and teams compared to big businesses.



Be kind to the environment!

Independent, community-serving businesses are smaller and consume less land, carry more locally-made products, are located closer to residents and create less traffic and air pollution.



Create more jobs.

Independent businesses employ more people directly per dollar of revenue and are also the customers of local printers, accountants, wholesalers, farms, etc.



Keep Louisville unique! Local communities are defined in large part by the businesses that reside there, and that plays a big factor in your overall satisfaction with where you live and the value of your home and property.

On average, 48 percent of each purchase at local independent businesses was recirculated locally, compared to less than 14 percent of purchases at chain stores.

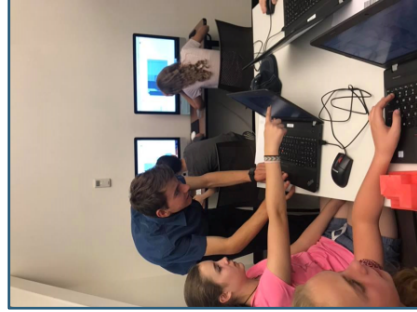
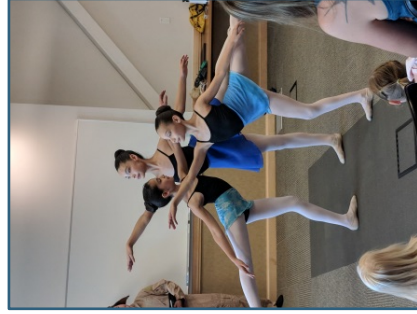
