ABOUT THE BUSINESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

If you plan to relocate your business to Louisville, or to significantly expand your existing Louisville business, you may qualify for assistance in the form of rebates.

REBATES BETWEEN
40-50%

Types of City rebates available include:

- ▶ Building Permit Fees
- ▶ Construction Use Tax
- ▶ Sales Tax
- ▶ Consumer Use Tax
- ▶ Enhanced Assistance
- ▶ Vacancy Bonus

Rebates generally range between 40–50% depending on the type of business and amount of investment being made, as well as the demonstrated match with program criteria. Businesses will need to submit a full Business Assistance Program application to include planned investment, employee growth, and community impact. An application needs to be submitted before any lease is signed or property is purchased. Applications will take about four weeks to bring to City Council once the application is full and complete.
